



**RESOLUTION NO. 1/2020
of the ReMedy International Scientific Committee**

of the 14th of January 2020

regarding changes in the composition of the ISC in the second term (2020-2024)

According to § 7 section 6 and 9 Statute of ReMedy "The Regenerative Mechanisms for Health" International Research Agenda Unit, the ReMedy International Scientific Committee resolves as follows:

§ 1

At the end of the current term (31.08.2020), the ISC membership will be adjusted to accommodate the requirement of a 50% turn-over at the end of the term. Thus, the ISC members of the first term: Profs. Leon Gradoń, Fatima Mechta-Grigoriou, Maciej Wieczorek, Michele Vendruscolo and Magdalena Żernicka-Goetz, will not serve in the second term. They are/will be replaced by Profs. Zofia Chrzanowska-Lightowlers, Mary Anne O'Connell, Annalisa Pastore, Phillip A. Sharp, and others, to be identified by the ISC at a later time. Profs. Peter Rehling, Witold Filipowicz, Ehud Gazit, Reinhard Lührmann, and Silvio Rizzoli will remain serving as members of the ISC for the second term.


In addition, the Chair of the ISC, Prof. Peter Rehling will step down from this position, remaining an active member of the Committee. The ISC strongly supports the candidacy of Prof. Phillip A. Sharp for the position of the ISC Chair in the second term.

Cumulatively, these changes accommodate the requirements of Regulations of ReMedy and the Foundation for Polish Science.
